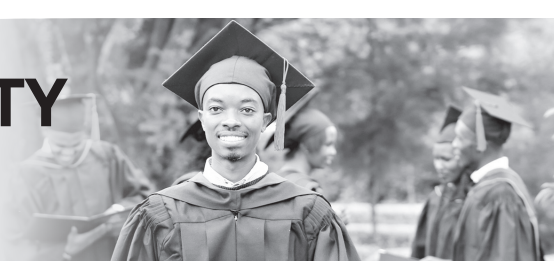

RICH HISTORY

The University is located in a serene and conducive teaching and learning environment in Thogoto, Kikuyu- the cradle of education in Kenya. It aims at producing holistically trained graduates for the service to God and Humanity. We embrace the values like academic excellence, freedom of thought, selfless service, discipline, integrity, transparency and fair play.

The Presbyterian University of East Africa has undergone a long historical academic journey. Thogoto mission area is where the first African secondary school (Alliance High School) was started by four alliance missionary churches (Church of Scotland Mission, Church Missionary Society, Methodist Church and African Inland Church). A theological college was established here in the late 1890's. It was known as "The Presbyterian College". This was the precursor to The Presbyterian University of East Africa (PUEA) established in 2007 to provide holistic and transformational faith-based university education.

Since then, the University has developed innovative and practical academic programmes across a wide range of disciplines. It has established a vibrant learning culture and attracted a large number of students at certificate, diploma, bachelor's and

master's degree levels. It is no surprise therefore that Kenya's founding father Mzee Jomo Kenyatta said in a speech delivered in 1968 during the inauguration of the 7th Anniversary celebrations of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA) that, *"Thogoto became a centre not only for religion, but also for education."*
