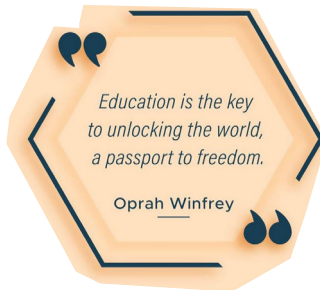
The Vice Chancellor's Message

RICH HISTORY

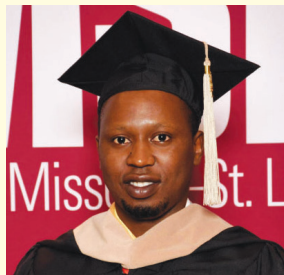
The Presbyterian University of East Africa is located in a serene and conducive teaching and learning environment at Thogoto (Scotland) Mission area, Kikuyu Constituency, Kiambu County, approximately 20km west of the city of Nairobi.

The university aims to at producing holistically trained graduates for service to God and to humanity. To achieve that goal we embrace the all-important academic values of excellence, freedom of thought, discipline, integrity, transparency and fairness.

The institution has undergone a long historical academic journey. Those are keen about the history of education in Kenya know that Thogoto occupies an important position as the cradle of education in the country. Thogoto mission area is where the first African secondary school (Alliance High School) was started by four alliance missionary churches (Church of Scotland Mission, Church Missionary Society, Methodist Church and African Inland Church). A theological college which came to be known as the 'The Presbyterian College' was established here in the late 1890's. This was the precursor to The Presbyterian University of East Africa. (PUEA) was established in 2007 and chartered in 2020. Today the University prouids itself for providing holistic and transformational faith-based university education.

The University has grown by leaps and bounds and has developed innovative and practical academic programmes across a wide range of disciplines. It has established a vibrant learning culture and attracted a large number of students at certificate, diploma, bachelors and master's levels. It is no surprise therefore that Kenya's founding father Mzee Jomo Kenyatta, who was trained in carpentry at Thogoto Scotland Missionary School, said in a speech delivered in 1968 during the inauguration of the 7th Anniversary celebrations of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA) that, "Thogoto became a

FUNDING

It is important to note that all 2022 KCSE graduates who qualified for university placement through Kenya Universities and Colleges Central Placement Service (KUCCPS) will be placed into both private and public universities as per their individual choices.

Under the new funding model announced by the government in March this year, students who will join private universities like the Presbyterian University of East Africa will be free to apply for government loans from the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB).

PUEA charges affordable fees with flexible terms of payment and offers a good number of scholarships.
